There, in the small chapel dedicated to Our Lady, they promised to work for the foundation of a new religious movement: a group called *Mary-ists*, whose life and ministry would be based on Mary's way of being faithful to God.

The commitment they made came to life in the birth of the Marist family and as such we are encouraged to know that everyday thousands of Marists wake up around the world willing to be the Good News in the lives of countless people.
